

Artwork Submissions Agreement

By consenting to the terms and conditions in this Artwork Submission Agreement (“Agreement”), you, the artist, are giving Carilson Designs Inc. permission to display your original artwork within the game environment of ‘Taskerville’.

Carilson Designs Inc. will not use original submissions of artwork in any other environment outside of the game ‘Taskerville’. This includes all mediums, methods or formats other than that which exists within ‘Taskerville’.

All submissions of artwork remain the property of the artist who is submitting them. Carilson Designs Inc. does not represent, in any way whatsoever, the artist themselves nor any of the artwork that is being submitted.

Though not necessary for purposes of the game, copyrighting your artwork is strongly recommended, as Carilson Designs Inc. will not be responsible for any artwork that is downloaded from the game by other players. Nor is Carilson Designs responsible if other people claim the artwork as their own, display said artwork outside of ‘Taskerville’ or is used in any other fashion outside of the game itself.

By submitting artwork for consideration for use in ‘Taskerville’, you represent that the artwork being submitted belongs to you and that you are the sole creator of the artwork. You will be responsible for any fees incurred by Carilson Designs Inc., including legal fees, as a result of any third party asserting a claim of creation or ownership of submitted artwork.

It is a requirement that all artists have a website containing the artwork which is being submitted for consideration to Carilson Designs Inc.

Submissions of artwork must be in groups of four, as collections of artwork by the same artist will be a part of the trading process within the game. Four pieces of artwork equals one collection. You can submit up to eight pieces of artwork equaling two collections.

It may be necessary to resize all submitted works of art to display in the environment of the game. We will never crop your work, nor use portions of the artwork itself in any form.

Original work cannot be sent by regular mail or other physical means of transport. If done so, Carilson Designs Inc. is not responsible for loss of artwork and will not be responsible for returning any artwork. Artwork must be photographed and submitted digitally, either in .png or .jpg format. If downloadable versions of your artwork are available on your website, we will be happy to download them from there once you tell us which pieces you want submitted. Otherwise, once you have submitted your email address, we will send you an email address which you may use to submit your work.

Art Requirements for submission of original work

Artwork selected for ‘Taskerville’ will be at the discretion of Carilson Designs Inc. which has established certain requirements for submissions including:

- ‘Taskerville’ takes place during the Middle Ages. Therefore, it is necessary that submissions not display modern tech or any representations of modern items or physical environments, which did not exist prior to the 1500s.
- All genres of Art will be considered, even if the genres themselves did not exist in the Middle Ages. This can include all forms of abstract art, surreal art, impressionist art, etc. Some digitally created artwork may not be considered if the work would have been impossible to create during the Middle Ages—this can include photographs or collages containing photographs or clippings of printed letters, among other items.

- Artwork must not be of a political nature, nor should it contain representations of racism, sexism or contain imagery of a derogatory nature toward any persons. Nor can images display any blatant acts of sexuality nor contain graphic violence against humans or against animals.

How chosen submissions of artwork will be used

There will be hundreds of works of art which will be randomly cycled through the game for players to own within the game. Many of these will be historic works of art and many of these will be original, contemporary works of art. Players can either buy artwork using in-game gems (not real currency) or earn artwork through various other means. Once a player has acquired a piece of artwork, it is displayed in their art gallery, which can be viewed by other players in a coalition. Artwork can also be traded for other artwork so that a player can own a collection by the same artist—adding to culture points in the game.

Once submitted artwork is chosen and made available for use in 'Taskerville', the artist will have an opportunity to have their artwork purchased through their own website. An information icon will be placed on the artwork which, when pressed, provides information, which may include the artist's name, contact information and whether the artwork is available for sale and/or if prints are available for purchase via the Artist's own website. The contact information can only include a website address and/or an email address. No phone numbers will be allowed, nor will business or home addresses be allowed.

Carlson Designs Inc. is not responsible for spam emails to your email address, or issues regarding visitors to your website address.
